

Master's degree

The Master's degree is a two-year course. The admission into **Master 1** (four years of higher education) is non-selective. Students must choose one of the following specialties:

private law and criminal science

public law

business law

European, international and comparative law

Political science - International relations

Law and Management of complex organizations

At the end of the first year, students may apply for the **second year Master** (five years of higher education). The admission into **Master 2** is selective (application form, interview...). Each Master 2 specialty is subdivided into various options.
