## OBJECTIVES

Erasmus Mundus Joint Masters (EMJM) are transnational degrees of excellence supported by the European Commission within the Erasmus+ programme.

The JANUS Master (Joint Master in Applied Defense and Security Networks for Unified Strategies) aims, over two years, to train **future leaders in public and private security**, capable of **understanding and analyzing the economic, political, technical, and cultural challenges of security governance**.

The programme, taught in **English and French**, draws on several academic fields: law, political science, criminology, economic intelligence, cybersecurity, information security, and management.

**Three of the four semesters are spent abroad**, across the following universities:

## 3 SEMESTERS ABROAD

First semester at Jean Moulin Lyon 3 University and second semester at Saint Joseph University in Beirut (mandatory) - Third semester at one of the three other universities (specialization).
