OBJECTIVES

Erasmus Mundus Joint Masters (EMJM) are transnational degrees of excellence supported by the European Commission within the Erasmus+ programme.

The JANUS Master (Joint Master in Applied Defense and Security Networks for Unified Strategies) aims, over two years, to train future leaders in public and private security, capable of understanding and analyzing the economic, political, technical, and cultural challenges of security governance.

The programme, taught in **English and French**, draws on several academic fields: law, political science, criminology, economic intelligence, cybersecurity, information security, and management.

Three of the four semesters are spent abroad, across the following universities:
